Federal Work Study

This program allows students to work on-campus for pay through federal financial aid.

To determine eligibility, please contact the CSU Financial Aid Office.

Loans

Perkins Loans: A relatively low interest loan students apply through the financial aid office.

Stafford Loans: Low interest loans that students borrow directly through the Federal government. There are two types: Subsidized and Unsubsidized

- Subsidized loans are need-based. Students are not charged interest while in school or during the grace period after graduation. These are “subsidized” by the federal government while the student is attending college.
- Unsubsidized loans do not require students to demonstrate financial need. However, these loans begin charging interest from the moment the money is made available to the student. Interest can be paid while in school or deferred until after graduation. However, deferment increases the loan amount and monthly payments.
